Kakdwip visit report – 12th. February 2023

On 12th. of February, myself, Supriyo Mondal and our Treasurer, Goutam Majumder alongwith our esteemed contributor Soumitra Ghosh, went to **Kakdwip**, to check on the student progress from that area.

Kakdwip is a sub-divisional town, situated about 87 Kms off Kolkata in South 24 Parganas district. Eight students (6 in Class 11 & 2 in Class 12 who'll write HS this year) from one institute there ("You Can Win" Educational Institute, Kakdwip) are enrolled with PRAYAAS.

This institute is run by **Chandrakanta Ghorai**, a 2014 batch BE (Mining) of IIEST, Shibpur and a local resident. The institute tutors for various entrance exams to professional studies, e.g., JEE Mains / WBJEE/NEET/ JENPAS-UG / JEXPO / GNM ANM Entrance etc. Students from far and distant villages in the region (quite a few from financially challenged families) are provided with hostel accommodation in the institute – they get enrolled in local HS schools and prepare here to write the aforesaid entrance exams. Expenses are very minimal as compared to such institutes in urban areas. Presently, 65 students stay and study here, with 17 teachers on board. Several of these students are often unable to pay fees regularly – they make part payments as & when their finances permit.

With help from Chandrakanta we could identify 8 students from the students of this institute, who are from financially challenged families.
